#### **DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

For General Cleaning of Lines, Tanks and other Equipment by Hand Brushing or Circulation Method:

- 1. Rinse all lines and equipment with clear water.
- 2. Make a cleaning solution using 3/4-1 oz. ECHO-CLOR per gallon of water and brush clean all equipment and circulate through all lines.
- 3. Rinse thoroughly with clean water and drain.
- 4. Allow to dry.

For Sanitizing Lines, Tanks and other Food and Beverage Processing and Handling Equipment:

1. Rinse all lines, tanks and equipment with clean water immediately after use.

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- 2. Clean with recommended Echo Product.
- 3. Rinse thoroughly with clean water and drain.
- 4. Sanitize Lines, Tanks and equipment immediately before re-use with a solution of 1½ oz. ECHO-CLOR in 3 gallons of water (100 ppm available chlorine).
- 5. For Pre-Cleaned Utensils immerse utensils in a solution of 1½ oz. ECHO-CLOR in 3 gallons of water (100 ppm available chlorine).

Allow sanitizing solution to remain in contact with surfaces for at least 2 minutes and drain.

For Spray Sanitizing—Use a solution of 1 oz. ECHO-CLOR in 1 gallon of water

(250 ppm available chlorine) making certain that all surfaces are contacted. Drain and allow to dry.

For Deodorizing—Wash walls, floors and other surfaces with a solution of 1 oz. ECHO-CLOR in 1 gallon water, rinse and let dry.


