DIRECTIONS

MOLES—First determine what sections of the network of ridged subsurface runways are repeatedly used by the mole by stepping on and pushing on the tunnel at numerous points about the premises. The following day at those points where the mole has reconstructed the collapsed tunnel, carefully punch a hole and drop in one tea-spoonful of bait. Close the hole with a plug of soil or a plug of vegetation, being careful not to collapse the tunnel.

GOPHERS—With the aid of a long handled spoon remove the soft earth plug leading underground and freshly thrown out around it. Using the long handled spoon, push the bait as far down into the burrow as the soil is loose. Use the same procedure on the surface to bait the hole. Push the bait down into the hole.

DANGER

Antidote:

If less than 1 hour has elapsed since the poisoning, give 1 tablespoon of saturated solution of sodium bicarbonate in water. Hold the patient down in a quiet room. If necessary, call a physician immediately.
