Foliage Spray

Apply to plants while plants are in leaf. Best results are obtained on plants less than 100 feet high. Apply during the period after the leaves have begun to fall and continue until the last of August. Mix with water in the ratio of 1 part of 2,4,5-T in 100 gallons of water. Apply to the leaves using sufficient pressure to spray the leaves thoroughly. Use sufficient pressure to spray the leaves thoroughly and thereby assure penetration.

Dormant Spray

Mix with water in the ratio of 1 part of Co-op 2,4,5-T to 100 parts of water. Apply to the dormant spray to the plants during the winter months. Apply to the plants during the winter months.

Basal Spray

Mix with water in the ratio of 1 part of Co-op 2,4,5-T to 100 parts of water. Apply to the basal spray to the plants during the winter months.

Stump Treatment

Mix with water in the ratio of 1 part of Co-op 2,4,5-T to 100 parts of water. Apply to the stump treatment to the plants during the winter months.

Frill Treatment

Mix with water in the ratio of 1 part of Co-op 2,4,5-T to 100 parts of water. Apply to the frill treatment to the plants during the winter months.
