Directions for Use

For cleaning and disinfecting floors, walls, painted surfaces, metal surfaces such as bed frames and cabinets use 4/5 oz. Lila-Phene per gallon of water—(1:160)
 For increased detergency in heavily soiled areas use 1 1/2 oz. Lila-Phene per gallon of water.
 Apply with sponge, cloth or mop. Lila-Phene will not dull waxed or finished floors when used as directed. No rinsing necessary.

DILUTION TABLE . . . Use Dilution 1:160
