DIRECTIONS:

For sanitizing glassware, silverware, dishes, cooking utensils, clean with suitable detergent (ICL Super-Kel-Kleen or D-Sol), rinse thoroughly, then dip into a solution of 1 oz. Odorless "A" per 4 gallons of water and let air dry.

For disinfecting in hospitals, public restrooms, rest homes and schools, after thoroughly cleaning with a suitable detergent apply Odorless "A" to walls, floors, bedframes, cabinets, with mop, cloth, or sponge using 1 oz. Odorless "A" per gallon of water.

For sanitizing in food processing plants, bakeries, dairies, poultry and meat plants after thoroughly cleaning surface to be sanitized, apply by spraying or sponging a solution of Odorless "A" at a recommended dilution of 200 ppm (1 oz. per 4 gal. water). It is not necessary to rinse surface after application. Maximum sanitizing effect is reached only if surface is not rinsed after application of sanitizing solution.

FOR ROOM FOGGING: To reduce the hazard of cross-infection from environmental surfaces, apply solution of Odorless "A" as a fog as described below, before applying standard routine terminal cleaning and disinfecting practices. 1. Remove all human, animal, and plant life from room. 2. Open closet doors and drawers. 3. Set up 34" revolving platform in center of room. 4. Mount Jet Challenger Sprayer Model 5.00C or other fogging device delivering equivalent spray at 3 RPM. 5. Fill sprayer reservoir with 1.5 oz. of Odorless "A" to 1 gallon of water to produce 1150 ppm active ingredients. 6. Set sprayer mechanism to deliver 1 gallon of solution. 7. Fog for 15 minutes for an average 2100 cu. ft. room. For different room sizes, vary spray time proportionately to ensure complete wetting of exposed surfaces. 8. Wait 2 hours before entering room after treatment. 9. Rinse fogging equipment thoroughly with clear water following use. We recommend room fogging only as an adjunct to acceptable manual cleaning and disinfecting procedures.

Rinse empty container thoroughly with water and discard it.
