DIRECTIONS FOR USE GENERAL CLASSIFICATION

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

WTM 40 is used to control algae and bacteria in recirculating commercial and industrial water cooling towers. Prior to its use, systems must be cleaned to remove algal growth, microbiological slime, and other deposits. An initial slug addition of 3.3 to 6.6 fluid ounces of WTM 40 per 1000 gallons of water is recommended. Repeat initial dosage until control is evident.

Subsequent slug additions of 1.1 to 6.6 fluid ounces of WTM 40 per 1000 gallons of water should be employed every 1 to 5 days, or as needed. The frequency of addition depends upon the relative amount of bleedoff and the severity of the microbiological problem. Slug additions should be made in the sump of water cooling towers.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

PROHIBITIONS: Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate that cannot be used or chemically reprocessed should be disposed of in a landfill approved for pesticides, or buried in a safe place away from water supplies.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL:

(1) METAL: Triple rinse (or equivalent) and offer for recycling, reconditioning, or disposal in an approved landfill or bury in a safe place. Containers over 30 gallons should be resealed before offering for reconditioning.

(2) PLASTIC: Containers under 30 gallons must not be reused but should be triple rinsed and disposed of in an incinerator or landfill approved for pesticide containers or buried in a safe place. Containers over 30 gallons are to be resealed and offered for reconditioning or triple rinsed (or equivalent) and offered for recycling, reconditioning, or disposal in an approved landfill or buried in a safe place.

GENERAL: Consult Federal, State, or Local disposal authorities for approved alternative procedures.

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its label.

Prior to using, brush away dust and dirt from area on the animal to be treated. JEL may be applied by hand or a soft cloth. Best results are obtained by treatment every second or third day depending upon insect pressure.

For treatment of Horses and Ponies to control STABLE FLIES & BITTING GNATS - apply thin film to the head, neck, belly and forelegs and flanks. Be sure to apply JEL to both the inside and outside of the ears.

FACE FLIES & HOUSE FLIES: Apply a thin film of JEL to the head area, paying particular attention to area around the nose and eyes. Avoid direct contact with eyes.

To protect minor cuts, scratches and abrasions from flies, apply thin film of JEL around and lightly over the wound area without coming in direct contact with open flesh. Do not apply to open cuts requiring professional services.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Do not contaminate water, food or feedstuff by storage or disposal.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash disposal.
