For best results use a good garden type or puffer type duster, using enough dust to lightly but thoroughly cover the foliage.

BEANS, PEAS, GRAPES, STRAWBERRIES, CABBAGE, BROCCOLI, KALE, MUSTARD, SPINACH, TURN 75, LETTUCE, ONIONS and POTATOES: For the control of aphids, spider mites, Mexican bean beetle, imported cabbage worm, cabbage looper, lace bug, onion thrip, and potato leafhopper - apply with thorough coverage and repeat as necessary. CAUTION: Do not use on leaf lettuce within 14 days of harvest or within 7 days of harvest of head lettuce or other crops listed.

ORNAMENTALS: For the control of aphids, mealy bugs, spider mites, white fly, tarnished plant bug, thrip, rose leafhopper, boxwood miner, bagworm, azalea scale, pine leaf scale, and Japanese beetles; apply with thorough coverage and repeat as necessary. Avoid use on certain ferns including Boston, Maidenhair and Pteris as well as on some species of Crassula.

DAIRY CATTLE: For the control of horn flies, apply 3 tablespoonfuls of 5% dust per animal. Apply the dust on the back and neck of the animals and repeat applications at 10 to 14 day intervals. Do not apply to dairy cattle later than five hours before milking or during milking. Do not contaminate feed, food containers and water troughs.

FLIFE: As an aid in the reduction of flies, dust around trash cans, garbage cans and breeding areas as needed. Breeding sites such as manure or other waste material should be eliminated. Do not use in dwellings or in milk rooms.

ANIMAL PESTS: For control of fleas on dogs and cats use enough dust to cover the animal lightly but thoroughly, then work into the hair coat using a softbristle brush. The neck hair should receive slightly heavier application of dust. If animals run free, reinfestations may occur and retreatments may be necessary every two or three weeks. Examine pets closely for reinfestations to avoid unnecessary treatments.

As an aid in the reduction of <u>fleas</u> in dog beds, kennels, pens and yards — first clean the area then dust thoroughly using 1 to 2 pounds per 1000 square feet. Pay special attention to areas where insects may be hiding.
