#### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Brown Patch (Rhizoctomia solami) of St. Augustine Grass: Brown Patch is caused by a soil-borne fungus which attacks during periods of high moisture level. The disease generally occurs in the Gulf Ceast area from September to about the end of May. The rate of spread varies with the time when infection takes place. A spot 2 or 3 inches in diameter may enlarge to cover an area several feet in diameter in 2 or 3 weeks.

Make one application at first indication of infection. Terraclor is a non-volatile, stable chemical, and theoretically should remain effective throughout the season. If, however, a treated area is subjected to unusually heavy irrigation, or rainfall, or flooded, it is suggested that the area be retreated.

APPLICATION: Apply 7-1/2 lbs. of this product per 1000 sq. ft. of lawn. It may be broadcast evenly by hand or with a lawn fertilizer spreader. Extreme care should be exercised to obtain even coverage for maximum benefit. Following application, the treated area should be lightly watered to insure movement of Terraclor through the grass to the soil level.

Cotton (Damping-off, Seed and Seedling Rets - Rhizoctonia): Furrow Application: Apply 10 lbs. per acre to the planting furrow. Apply over seed and covering soil at planting time, using suitable application equipment.
