Spray all the soil that surrounds and covers the seed. Two nozzles work best; center the front nozzle over the open furrow to spray soil around the seed and the rear nozzle to spray covering soil as it fills the furrow.

COTTON SEED TREATMENT: Mix 8 - 12 oz. with 1 - $1\frac{1}{2}$ pints of water and spray onto 100 lbs. of seed. Soil applications are required for later stages of pre-emergent and post-emergent damping-off. Treated seed should be labeled "Treated seed--do not use for food, feed or oil purposes."
