

Calcium Hypochlorite * 65.0%
Inert Ingredients 35.0%

*Available Chlorine 65%

Directions for Use: It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

1. Maintain a pH between 7.2 - 7.6. Adjust with HTH PH Plus or HTH PH Minus as necessary.
2. Superchlorinate on a routine basis with HTH(R) Sock-It. Follow label instructions.
3. As a starting point, use three (3) tablets per 10,000 gallons. For stabilized pools: Use one (1) tablet as a starting point.
4. Place tablet(s) in empty skimmer basket. (Do not remove plastic wrapper from the tablet(s)).
5. Using test kit, check free available chlorine residual after one day; increase or decrease the number of tablets to maintain 1-3 ppm.
6. When tablets are dissolved, remove empty plastic wrapper and replace with new tablet(s) as needed.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

DANGER

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Keep this product dry in a tightly closed container, when not in use. Store in a cool, dry, well ventilated area away from heat or open flame. In case of decomposition, isolate container (if possible) and flood area with large amounts of water to dissolve all materials before discarding this container. Do not reuse empty container but place in trash collection. Do not contaminate food or feed by storage or disposal, or cleaning of equipment.
