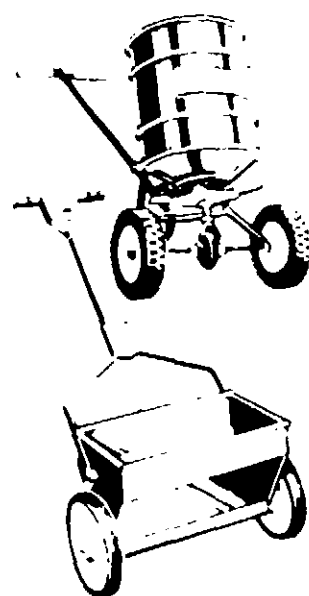

GRASS LAWNS: Ammo-Phos Lawn Fertilizer with Betolan Herbicide may be used safely on these well-established lawns: Bahia grass, Bentgrass, Bermudagrass, Bluegrass, Centipede, Fescue, Paspalum, Perennial Ryegrass, Red Top, Poa Trivialis, St. Augustine and Zoysa. It may be applied safely to dormant lawns at or after seeding.

ORNAMENTALS AND GROUND COVERS: Ammo-Phos Lawn Fertilizer with Betolan Herbicide may be applied safely to these well-established ornamentals and ground covers: Alysium, Aster, Calendula, Daffodil, Dahlia, Abelia, Azalea, Azara, A. J. C. Camponotus, Boxwood, Candytuft, Coral Bell, Daisy, Marigold, Freesia, Gladiolus, Daphne, Holly, Juniper, Monterey Cypress, Gazania, Hypericum, Ice Plant, Pansy, Primrose, Stock, Sweet Pea, Narcissus, Ranunculus, Monterey Pine, Myrtle, Pernettya, Pyracantha, Ivy, Pachysandra, Penstemon, Wall Flower, Zinnia, Tulip, Sandersonia, Star of David, Xylocarpus, Sedum, Wild Strawberry and Bachelors Button.

HOW TO APPLY: Application is recommended on mineral soils and must precede emergence of weeds. An application in September or October is recommended for spring and summer control of crabgrass and other annual weeds, such as poa annua, henbit, watergrass. Crabgrass usually emerges 4 to 6 weeks before it is visible in a lawn. If this period is missed, an application may be made in early spring, but it must be made before weeds or crabgrass emerge. In Southern and Western States where crabgrass and other annual weeds emerge in late summer and fall, a second application may be needed 4 to 5 months after the first application. Do not apply this product more than twice in any 12-month period. Use Ammo-Phos Lawn Fertilizer for continued feeding.

HOW TO APPLY: Remove leaves, dead or tall grass and other debris before applying. Use a lawn spreader and apply uniformly. Apply 20 pounds of Ammo-Phos Lawn Fertilizer with Betolan Herbicide per 1,000 square feet. Water thoroughly after application. Do not reseed or overseed any treated area within 4 months of application.



Crab Grass Two Year Old Spread Width
 5.75 6 feet

1. Measure two square feet approximately two feet square. Fill with Ammo-Phos Lawn Fertilizer with Betolan Herbicide. Spread evenly over the two square feet.

2. Determine the square footage of your lawn. Divide the square footage by 50 to determine the number of 20 lb. bags of Ammo-Phos Lawn Fertilizer with Betolan Herbicide you will need.

3. Apply the Ammo-Phos Lawn Fertilizer with Betolan Herbicide to your lawn. Water thoroughly after application.

4. All material applied in the 60 feet square should be applied to the entire lawn. Do not apply to the lawn before the material has been applied to the entire lawn.

Measure a 60 foot length of lawn. Walk the length of the lawn with the spreader to determine the setting. Over the 60 foot length, the spreader should deliver 20 pounds of Ammo-Phos Lawn Fertilizer with Betolan Herbicide. All material applied in the 60 foot square should be applied to the entire lawn. Do not apply to the lawn before the material has been applied to the entire lawn.
