STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT (First Aid Procedures)

If in eyes: Flush with plenty of water. Get medical attention.
If on skin: Wash with plenty of soap and water and repeat after ten minutes if persists.
Inhalation: Remove to fresh air.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

Do not apply directly to fish, ponds or streams. Do not apply to areas where water may collect. Do not contaminate surface water or ground water.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Flammable liquid. Harmful if swallowed. Irritating to eyes and skin.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

For control of soil-borne diseases. Apply directly to soil surface at rate of 1/2 lb./100 sq. ft.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Terrazole is used as a soil fungicide for control of damping off, root and stem diseases caused by *Fusarium* and *Pythium*.
Use only at recommended rates. Do not mix with other chemicals other than Terrazole unless prior use has been compatibility.

BEDDING PLANTS

Annuals: Add 1/2 to 1 lb./sq. ft. Add 1 to 2 to 25 gallons of water and apply to bed soil. If soil is dry, a liberal application may be made. Water to the soil every 10 days during hot weather.

TROPICAL FOLIAGE, HERBACEOUS and WOODY PLANTS

(Ferns and other herbaceous material to depth)

Bed and Bench Planting: Add 1 to 2 lbs. of 1/2 gallon of water and apply to bed soil. If soil is dry, a liberal application to the soil every 10 days during dry weather.

Pot Planting: Use 1 pot solution per 6 in. pot or one cup of soil amendment to each 10 in. pot.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

PROHIBITIONS: Do not store with food or feed by storage or disposal. Open containers must be closed.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Do not store near any that cannot be washed away according to EPA regulations. Do not pour into any body of water, stream, or river.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Do not burn containers. Do not bury containers. Do not use containers for any other purpose.
