


No Rubbing, Scrubbing, Scouring



For use on: Roofs, Siding, Driveways, Patios,
Gutters, Outdoor Furniture, Boats, Campers,
Trailers — removes mildew effortlessly.

Directions For Use:

To kill and destroy mildew, mold, and fungus on contact,
use the following procedure:

- 1 Mix 1/3 cup of Olin Minute Mildew Rid per gallon of warm water. A plastic bucket is recommended.
- 2 Apply solution liberally with a sprayer, mop, sponge or brush to the mildewed area. Use of plastic or rubber gloves recommended.
- 3 Ten minutes after application or when mildew stains disappear, rinse thoroughly by hosing with clear water.
- 4 Repeat Olin Minute Mildew Rid application if new growth appears.




