DIRECTIONS FOR USE GENERAL CLASSIFICATION

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.
In Seawater Displacement Liquid Hydrocarbon Storage Tanks.

For inhibition of sulfate reducing bacteria for up to 36 weeks in clean (free of slime and sludge) seawater displacement tanks used for the storage of liquid hydrocarbons. Dissolve 1 lb. of OMADINE TBAO in 5 gallons of water and feed directly to the incoming seawater ballast at the rate of 1 gallon per 600 gallons seawater. Repeat dosage as needed or whenever the storage tank is drained and refilled. Before draining the treated seawater from the tank, treat with calcium hypochlorite (65% active) at the rate of 50 ounces (avdp) per 3,000 gallons water. Wait 24 hours before discharging the seawater. This procedure will destroy the preservative.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not store above 100° F (38° C). Store in a dry place. Keep container tightly closed when not in use. Do not store with strong oxidizing agents or strong (concentrated) acids.

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited. Unused contents could be disposed of in a landfill approved for pesticides. Do not reuse empty container. Triple rinse with water and: (1) if container is metal, offer for recycling, reconditioning or disposal in approved landfill; (2) if container is plastic, dispose of in an incinerator (Do not breathe fumes) or landfill approved for pesticide containers. Consult Federal, State, or Local disposal authorities for approved alternate procedures.
