2. On the center panel, delete the wordings "... & related compounds...".
3. On the right panel, the listed reentry statement must be added: "...Reentry into treated swimming pool is prohibited above levels of 3 ppm of chlorine...".

4. Under the directions for use, the label needs to be expanded to reflect the attached enclosure for treatment of swimming pools with chlorinated products.

5. Under the heading "Directions for Use" add the Misuse statement, "It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling."

6. Refer to the enclosed copy of Isocyanurate RED Attachment A for the necessary revisions to the Precautionary Statements for the subject product label.

A stamped copy of the product label is enclosed for your records.

Submit one copy of the final printed labeling before releasing the product in channels of trade with the revised labeling.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS; HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS**
