## DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Formulated for planter box treatment of soybeans for control of Rhizoctonia, Pythium and Fusarium related seed and soil-borne seedling disease complex. Seed should be sound, well-cured and cleaned prior to planting. Use only the recommended rates.

**PLANTER BOX TREATMENT:** Mix 4 - 9 fl. oz. per bushel of seed just prior to planting and plant at the rate of approximately one bushel of treated seeds per acre. (Note: where Molybdenum is required, the 4-ounce rate is equivalent to 0.25 oz. Mo as metallic per acre.) Keep container tightly closed when not in use. Do not feed treated seed to animals. Planter boxes should be flushed with water at the end of each day's operations and thoroughly cleaned at the conclusion of the planting season.

## STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

**Prohibitions:** Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

**Container Disposal:** Rinse containers and dispose of in an incinerator or landfill approved for pesticide containers.

**General:** Consult Federal, State or local disposal authorities for approved alternative procedures such as limited open burning.
