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DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

When used as directed, Olin HTH® Algaecide will kill and control the growth of green, blue-green, and other swimming pool algae. Olin HTH® Algaecide is compatible with most commonly used swimming pool chemicals, but it should not be mixed with soap or other water treating chemicals. Olin HTH® Algaecide works best when added in several places by itself directly to pool water with the pump running. Wait 15 minutes before entry of swimmers. Pools, spas, whirlpools, and hot tubs with heavy growth of algae should be cleaned prior to using Olin HTH® Algaecide.

**INITIAL DOSE:** Add 1 gallon OLIN HTH® Algaecide to 50,000 gallons of water when filling pool at beginning of season.

**MAINTENANCE DOSE:** Add 1 quart Olin HTH® Algaecide to 50,000 gallons of pool water at 3-5 day intervals. If high temperatures prevail or pool has unusually heavy use, add maintenance dose more frequently. If make-up water is added at the rate of more than 10% of pool capacity per week, add 1 quart of Olin HTH® Algaecide for each 10,000 gallons of fresh make-up water added per week.

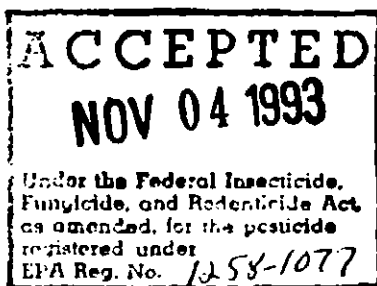
**VISIBLE ALGAE:** If pool has slight visible algae growth, treat with "Initial Dose" above. Vacuum pool after 24 hours to remove algae debris. If visible algae are still present or re-appear, repeat this treatment as necessary. When pool is free of visible algae, use the "Maintenance Dose" above.

**WINTERIZING:** When swimming season is over, add 1 gallon Olin HTH® Algaecide to 50,000 gallons of pool water. This dose helps provide a measure of control of algae growth during the winter months and helps the servicing of the pool before it is returned to use the following season.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE IN OUTSIDE SPAS/WHIRLPOOLS/HOT TUBS

**INITIAL DOSE:** Add 12.8 ounces of Olin HTH® Algaecide per 5,000 gallons of water. Initial dose is used upon filling of outside spa/whirlpool/hot tub bath.

**MAINTENANCE DOSE:** Add 3.2 ounces of Olin HTH® Algaecide per 5,000 gallons of water. Maintenance dose should be added at 3-5 day intervals. If high temperatures prevail or outside spa/whirlpool/hot tub bath has unusually heavy use, add maintenance dose more frequently. Drain and clean outside spa/whirlpool/hot tub bath at least once a month or as needed depending upon bather load.

DANGER

Keep Out of Reach of Children. Corrosive. Causes severe eye and skin damage. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Wear goggles or face shield and rubber gloves when handling. Harmful or fatal if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes, call a physician. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse. If swallowed, drink promptly a large quantity of milk, egg whites, gelatin solution or, if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol. Call a physician.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN

Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory shock as well as oxygen and measures to support breathing manually or mechanically may be needed. If persistent, convulsions may be controlled by the cautious intravenous injection of a short-acting barbituate drug.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This pesticide is toxic to fish. Do not discharge into lakes, streams, ponds or public waters unless in accordance with a NPDES permit. For guidance, contact your Regional Office of the Environmental Protection Agency.

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STORAGE AND DISPOSAL (12 Pt Type)

- DO NOT CONTAMINATE WATER, OR FOOD, OR FEED BY STORAGE OR DISPOSAL.
