
# **Conditions**

- Under the "Storage and Disposal" statements, delete the statement,"Do not contaminate 2. water, food, or feed by storage and disposal."
- Under the "Directions for Swimming Pools," place the "Visible Algae" directions below 3. the Initial Dose.
- Under the "Directions for Spas and Hot Tubs," revise the "Initial Treatment to read: 4.

"Add 1 oz per 390 gallons of water. Initial dose is used upon filling of Spa/Hot Tub. For visible algae growth or slimy interior, treat with "Initial Dose." Remove algae debris.

For maximum effectiveness, spas containing heavy algae growth should be drained and cleaned prior to treatment.


