This product is used to control the growth of algae in swimming pools, exterior spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, decorative fountains and [synthetically lines] ponds that do not contain fish. For maximum effectiveness, pools, spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, decorative fountains and [synthetically lined] ponds containing heavy growth of algae should be cleaned prior to using this product.

This is to meet requirements for the state of New York.

This notification is consistent with the provisions of PR Notice 98-10 and EPA regulations at 40 CFR 152.46, and no other changes have been made to the labeling or the confidential statement of formula of this product. I understand that it is a violation of 18 U.S.C., Sec. 1001 to willfully make any false statement to the EPA. I further understand that if this notification is not consistent with the terms of PR Notice 98-10 and 40 CFR 152.46, this product may be in violation of FIFRA and I may be subject to Enforcement action and penalties under sections 12 and 14 of FIFRA.

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE:** It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

#### READ THE PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS BEFORE USE.

This product is used to control the growth of algae in swimming pools, exterior spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, decorative fountains and [synthetically lined] ponds that do not contain fish. For maximum effectiveness pools, spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, decorative fountains and [synthetically lined] ponds containing heavy growth of algae should be cleaned prior to using this product.

For pools having just visible algae growth add an initial dose of 24 to 36 fluid ounces of this product per 10,000 gallons of water and remove settled algae debris by cleaning. For treatment of a freshly cleaned and filled pool add initially 13 to 24 fluid ounces of this product per 10,000 gallons of water.

Subsequent additions of 4 to 9 fluid ounces of this product per 10,000 gallons of water should be made every 5 to 7 days after initial treatment for maintenance.

Spas, whirlpools, or hot tubs having just visible algae growth require an initial dose of 2 to 4 fluid ounces of this product per 1,000 gallons of water. For treatment of freshly cleaned and filled spa, whirlpool, hot tub, decorative fountain or pond, add initially 1 to 2 fluid ounces per 1,000 gallons of water. Subsequent addition of 0.5 to 0.8 fluid ounces of this product hould be made every 5 to 7 days after initial treatment for maintenance.

This product will prevent the growth of most algae during the off-season winter months when pools are not in use. For pools which have been properly treated during the swimming season and are free of visible algae, add 13 to 21 fluid ounces of this product per 10,000 gallons of water. If at the end of the swimming season pools have some visible algae growth, add 25 to 37 fluid ounces of this product per 10,000 gallons of water. It is necessary that a uniform distribution of this product be made throughout the water for maximum effectiveness. If pool is not covered, it may be necessary to repeat the treatment one or more times during the season.

This product may be used in the same pool treatment program as most chemicals normally used to treat pools and spas and is effective at both acid and alkaline pH. This product can be used in pools and spas treated with chlorine chemicals and may reduce the amount of those chemicals normally required. However, do not mix this product with other materials, including concentrated dry or liquid chlorine products.
