


3. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-72 inclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

For pools having just visible algae growth add an initial dose of 11 to 17 fluid ounces of OLIN HTH[®] All Purpose Algacide per 10,000 gallons of water and remove settled algae debris by cleaning. For treatment of a freshly cleaned and filled pool add initially 6 to 11 fluid ounces of OLIN HTH[®] All Purpose Algacide per 10,000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of 2 to 4 fluid ounces of OLIN HTH[®] All Purpose Algacide per 10,000 gallons of water should be made every 5 to 7 days after initial treatment for maintenance.

Spas, whirlpools, or hot tubs having just visible algae growth require an initial dose of 1 to 1.1 fluid ounces of OLIN HTH[®] All Purpose Algacide per 1,000 gallons of water. For treatment of freshly cleaned and filled spa, whirlpool, or hot tub, add initially 0.6 to 1.1 fluid ounces of OLIN HTH[®] All Purpose Algacide per 1,000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of 0.2 to 0.4 fluid ounces of OLIN HTH[®] All Purpose Algacide should be made every 5 to 7 days after initial treatment for maintenance.

OLIN HTH[®] All Purpose Algacide is compatible with those chemicals normally used to treat pools and spas and is effective at both acid and alkaline pH. OLIN HTH[®] All Purpose Algacide can be used in pools and spas treated with chlorine chemicals and may reduce the amount of those chemicals normally required. However, do not mix OLIN HTH[®] All Purpose Algacide with concentrated dry or liquid chlorine products.
