For pools which have been properly treated during the swimming season and are free of visible algae, add 7 to 11 fluid ounces of this product per 10 000 gallons of water. If at the end of the swimming season pools have some visible algae growth, add 13 to 19 fluid ounces of this product per 10 000 gallons of water. It is necessary that a uniform distribution of this product be made throughout the water for maximum effectiveness.
