NECESSARY PRECAUTIONS

DIRECTIONS FOR COMMERCIAL LAUNDRY SANITIZER:

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

This product can be fed to the laundry water using a suitable solid chlorine feeder. A solid chlorine feeder consisting of a container with a support mechanism for the tablets and a water spray impinging on the tablets may be used. The amount of available chlorine dispensed is controlled by adjusting the spray time to give 100 ppm available chlorine in the laundry water. The chlorine solution is used for the bleach or sanitizing cycle. Test the level of available chlorine and add more of this product if it has dropped below 100 ppm.
