DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. This product is designed to dissolve slowly providing a steady source of available chlorine in swimming pools to control the growth of algae, kill bacteria and destroy organic contaminants.

[For best results, follow a weekly program with our [brand] System. Consult your authorized [brand] dealer for advice on the system that best suits your pool and your lifestyle.] [Take a pool water sample to your authorized [brand] dealer regularly for a detailed water sample.]

READ THE PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS BEFORE USE.

One tablet will provide an effective chlorine residual of 1-3 parts per million (ppm) in 20,000 gallons of pool water for up to 2 weeks under normal use conditions. Use only in [skimmers or] feeders made specifically for this size tablet. Do not allow this product to get damp or wet before use. Do not allow this product to contact other water treatment products.

- (1) Adjust pH to the ideal range of 7.2 7.6
- (2) Bring chlorine residual to 1 3 ppm using appropriate chlorine shock product. Follow label instructions.
- (3) Stabilize the pool with cyanuric acid. Follow label instructions.
- (4) Ensure that the [skimmer basket or] feeder is free of any other chemicals, tablets or residue prior to use. DO NOT use in floaters or feeders that have been used with other dry chlorinating products. Place this product in the [skimmer basket or] feeder. If placed in skimmer, run the filter pump a minimum of eight hours daily. Make sure skimmer is completely clean and free of residue from other water treatment products before putting this product in the skimmer. This product is not recommended for use in vinyl lined pools without an automatic timer on the pool filter pump. Pump should run a minimum of 8 hours per day, otherwise vinyl liner damage may occur. If chlorine residual goes above 3 ppm, reduce [skimmer or] feeder flow rate [or daily pump operation time]. If chlorine residual goes below 1 ppm, increase [skimmer or] feeder flow rate or daily pump operation time. Shock treat weekly or every other week with appropriate shock treatment. Follow label directions. Do not reenter pool until chlorine residual is 1 3 ppm. [When the plastic sleeve is empty, remove it from the pool skimmer and replace it with a new tablet.]
 - DO NOT use with any other tablets or sticks in the same skimmer, floater or feeder.
 - DO NOT permit tablets to contact plastic pool linings or metal objects.
 - DO NOT throw tablets directly into pool.
 - [DO NOT pre-mix this product.] [Only add this product directly to your pool.]
