FOR INITIAL APPLICATION IN POOLS SANITIZED WITH POOLIFE® OR POOL BREEZE® PRODUCTS:

Backwash and clean filter. Balance your pool water and adjust pH between 7.2 - 7.6. Add 2 lbs. of ENDURE per 1,000 gallons of pool water by broadcasting the product over the surface of the pool with the pump running. This initial treatment should be added in three doses with one third of the required amount being added each application. Brush any undissolved product from the bottom of the pool. The pH of the pool water will rise as a normal reaction to the introduction of ENDURE. One hour after each application, adjust the pH to 7.2 - 7.6 with pH decreaser, according to label directions. Allow at least 8 hours between the applications of ENDURE. Do not add additional product until the pH is between 7.2 - 7.6 (NOTE: For every 2 pounds of ENDURE, approximately 1 pound of pH decreaser will be required for pH adjustment). Within 10 days, take a water sample to your dealer to test for water balance and to determine if an adequate amount of this product has been added.

FOR INITIAL APPLICATION IN POOLS SANITIZED WITH BAQUACIL® POOL CARE SYSTEM:

Backwash and clean filter. Balance your pool water and adjust pH between 7.2 - 7.6. Add 4 lbs. of ENDURE per 1,000 gallons of pool water by broadcasting the product over the surface of the pool with the pump running. This initial treatment should be added in three doses with one third of the required amount being added each application. The pH of the pool water will rise as a normal reaction to the introduction of this product therefore, one hour after each application, adjust the pH to 7.2 - 7.6 with pH decreaser, according to label directions. Allow at least 8 hours between the applications of ENDURE. Do not add additional ENDURE until the pH is between 7.2 - 7.6 (NOTE: For every 2 pounds of ENDURE, approximately 1 pound of pH decreaser will be required for pH adjustment). Within 10 days, take a water sample to your dealer to test for water balance and to determine if an adequate amount of this product has been added.

FOR MAINTENANCE APPLICATION:

This product is stable in pool water and not degraded by sunlight. The primary loss of product is through splash-out, backwashing and dilution from heavy rains. Therefore, once the initial application is made, minor and infrequent additions would be all that is required unless a substantial amount of water is drained from the pool.

This notification is to make minor label changes resulting from the recent transfer of pesticide registrations from Number 72674 (Avecia) to Number 1258 (Arch Chemicals). The labels have been modified to include:

1. Removal of the warranty statement, which read:

NOTICE TO BUYER AND USER - LIMITED WARRANTY FROM AVECIA INC. ("Avecia.") warrants that this product conforms to the chemical description on the label, and that it is reasonably fit for the purposes stated on the label when used in accordance with Avecia's instructions. This warranty does not extend to the use of this product contrary to label instructions, or under abnormal use conditions. Avecia will replace the product or refund the purchase price at your option should this warranty be breached within one year of sale. THE DURATION OF ANY IMPLIED WARRANTIES IS LIMITED TO ONE YEAR. Some states do not allow limitations on how long an implied warranty lasts, so the above limitations may not apply to you. IN NO EVENT SHALL AVECIA BE LIABLE FOR ANY SPECIAL, INCIDENTAL OR CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES, INCLUDING LOST PROFITS, and no person is authorized to alter the terms of Avecia's warranty. Some states do not allow the exclusion or limitation of incidental or consequential damages, so the above limitation or exclusion may not apply to you. For warranty assistance, write Business Manager, BAQUACIL, Wilmington, DE 19850. This warranty gives you specific legal rights and you may have other rights which vary from state to state.

2. Change EPA registration number from Avecia to Arch.

3. Change name, address, trademark ownership and phone number from Avecia to Arch.

Even though notification is not necessary for company designation and EPA registration Number, this notification is being submitted to also include the removal of the Warranty statement.

This notification is consistent with the provisions of PR Notice 98-10 and EPA regulations at 40 CFR 152.46, and no other changes have been made to the labeling or the confidential statement of formula of this product. I understand that it is a violation of 18 U.S.C., Sec. 1001 to willfully make any false statement to the EPA. I further understand that if this notification is not consistent with the terms of PR Notice 98-10 and 40 CFR 152.46, this product may be in violation of FIFRA and I may be subject to Enforcement action and penalties under sections 12 and 14 of FIFRA.
