This notification is to make minor label changes resulting from the recent transfer of pesticide registrations from Number 72674 (Avecia) to Number 1258 (Arch Chemicals). The labels have been modified to include:

1. Removal of the warranty statement, which read:

("Avecia.") warrants that this product conforms to the chemical description on the label, and that it is reasonably fit for the purposes stated on the label when used in accordance with Avecia's instructions. This warranty does not extend to the use of this product contrary to label instructions, or under abnormal use conditions. Avecia will replace the product or refund the purchase price at your option should this warranty be breached within one year of sale. THE DURATION OF ANY IMPLIED WARRANTIES IS LIMITED TO ONE YEAR. Some states do not allow limitations on how long an implied warranty lasts, so the above limitations may not apply to you. IN NO EVENT SHALL AVECIA BE LIABLE FOR ANY SPECIAL, INCIDENTAL OR CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES, INCLUDING LOST PROFITS, and no person is authorized to alter the terms of Avecia's warranty. Some states do not allow the exclusion or limitation of incidental or consequential damages, so the above limitation or exclusion may not apply to you. For warranty assistance, write Business Manager, BAQUACIL, Wilmington, DE 19850. This warranty gives you specific legal rights and you may have other rights which vary from state to state.

2. Change EPA registration number from Avecia to Arch.

3. Change name, address, trademark ownership and phone number from Avecia to Arch.

Even though notification is not necessary for company designation and EPA registration Number, this notification is being submitted to also include the removal of the Warranty statement.

This notification is consistent with the provisions of PR Notice 98-10 and EPA regulations at 40 CFR 152.46, and no other changes have been made to the labeling or the confidential statement of formula of this product. 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It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

TO MAINTAIN PROPER CHLORINE RESIDUAL

For optimum results, the pH of the swimming pool water should be maintained between 7.2 and 7.6. A Chlorine stabilizer (cyanuric acid) should also be used to prevent extreme fluctuations in the chlorine level. To satisfy the chlorine demand of the water, use repeated dosages of this product of 1/3 cup (2.7 oz. by wt.) for each 5,000 gallons of water as necessary. One ounce of product by weight per 5,000 gallons of water will apply approximately 0.5 ppm available chlorine residual. To maintain a desired level of 1.0 to 1.5 ppm of chlorine residual, add 1/3 cup of product for each 5,000 gallons of water daily or as needed. Once every 10 days or two weeks the pool water should be shocked with this product to prevent the development of resistant species of algae. Use a test strip for chlorine and pH control.

SHOCK TREATMENT

Utilizing your test kit, adjust pH of pool water to 7.2-7.6. Use 1 pound of product (approx. 2 cups) for each 10,000 gallons of water in the evening when the pool will not be used for a minimum of 12 hours. Test the chlorine residual and if above 2.0 ppm do not allow swimming until residual has decreased.
