

SWIMMING POOL ALGICIDE

Baquacil 795 can be used in both residential and commercial swimming pools.

Baquacide 795 when used as directed is effective against green (Chlorella pyrenoidosa), black (Phoridium luridum), blue-green (Lyngbya versicolor) and mustard algae (Pleurochloris meiringensis) as well as pink and white slime producing organisms.

TREATING POOL

INITIAL DOSE: Add 5 fluid ounces of *Baquacide 795* per 10,000 gallons of pool water into the skimmer or directly to the pool with the pump running. Run pump for at least 6 hours after application. Wait at least 15 minutes after application before entering pool.

Initial dose is used at time a pool has been newly converted to chlorine or Baquacil Sanitizer and Algistat or at the beginning of each new pool season

MAINTENANCE DOSE: Weekly add 1 1/2 fluid ounces of *Baquacide 795* per 10,000 gallons of pool water into the skimmer or directly to the pool with the pump running.

Maintenance doses should also be added immediately after moderate to high rainfall, heavy pool usage or periods of high temperature. This will help prevent algae and slime producing microorganism growth.

Baquacide 795 (1258-) Draft Label **VISIBLE ALGAE AND SLIME:** Brush algae from walls and clean skimmer area. Add 5 fluid ounces of **Baquacide 795** per 10,000 gallons of pool water into the skimmer or directly to the pool with the pump running.

PERSISTENT ALGAE AND SLIME PRODUCING MICROORGANISMS: Add 5 fluid ounces of **Baquacide 795** per 10,000 gallons of pool water into the skimmer with the pump off. If there is more than one skimmer split the dose between skimmers. Turn pump on for one minute and immediately turn pump off. Allow pump to remain off overnight. The following day restart the pump and add 5 fluid ounces of **Baquacide 795** per 10,000 gallons of pool water directly to the pool. Frequently brush pool sides and bottom and run filter continuously for 24 – 48 hours.

POOL CLOSING OR END OF SEASON: Add 5 fluid ounces of *Baquacide 795* per 10,000 gallons of pool water into the skimmer or directly to the pool with the pump running.

Baquacide 795 Swimming Pool Algicide aids in the prevention of algae in outdoor whirlpools, spas and hot tubs.

Fill whirlpool, spa or hot tub with water. Add 1/8 ounce per 200 gallons of water (2 ppm active). Run pump and wait at least 15 minutes after application before entering. Drain whirlpool, spa or hot tub after each use and disinfect with a suitable disinfectant.
