This letter acknowledges receipt of the Notification identified above submitted under the provisions of section 3(c)(9) of the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended and PR Notice 98-10. This Notification requests:

- Relocation of First Aid and Precautionary Statements to page 2
- Addition of optional statement 'Peligro', Spanish translation of 'Danger'
- Addition of the statement "Read all precautionary statements and first aid statements before use" to the front panel
- Relocation of the company name, address, EPA registration number, and EPA establishment number to the first page
- Deletion of NPIC emergency contact information
- Dosage tables combined into one chart
- Reference to dosage table in 'Maintenance-Monthly' section
- Reduction in maintenance dosage rate in dosage table

In addition, the following changes were noticed and are acceptable:

- "Inert ingredients" replaced with "other ingredients"
- Removal of sentence "FOR DISPOSAL OF A CONTAMINATED OR DECOMPOSING PRODUCT SEE EMERGENCY HANGLING" from storage & disposal directions

Application for Label Notification

Dear Mr. Swindell:

I am submitting an application to make the following changes to the above named product label:

- 1. First Aid and Precautionary Statements have been moved to page 2, and add a Note to reviewer and the following referral statement have been added to page 1: "See [left] [right] [back] [side] panel for Precautionary and First Aid Statements." The reason we are asking for this allowance is due to the size of some of our packaging. The smaller sizes present a challenge to fit all of the required language on the front panel. Our note to reviewer includes the statement, "If the First Aid Statements are placed on the front panel of the final graphic label, the statement below will not be used." The intent of that statement is that when space is not an issue, the First Aid language would appear on the front panel and the referral statement would not be used.
- 2. Add the Spanish translation to DANGER (PELIGRO) as optional for the front panel.
- 3. Add the statement "Read all precautionary statements and first aid statements before use" to the front panel.
- 4. Move the company name, address, and EPA numbers to the first page.
- 5. Delete the following paragraph that was located below the First Aid section: "For emergency information on this product you may also call the National Pesticides Information Center at 1-800-858-7378, 6:30 AM to 4:30 PM Pacific time (PT), seven days a week. During other times, call the poison control center: 1-800-222-1222." This information is not on any of our cother registrations and is not required on consumer pesticidal products. Riease note that we already have our own emergency phone number on the label (IN CASE OF EMERGENCY CALL: 1-800-654-6911).
- 6. Minor revisions to the use directions to provide better consumer clarity. The changes are highlighted on page 5 of the enclosed proposed label.
 - a. Combined the two separate dosage tables into one chart.
 - b. Under Maintenance Monthly section: Made a reference to the dosage table:

c. In the Dosage Table: reduce the Maintenance dosage rate. A reduction is requested based on consumer testing.
