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
i. On the front panel of the label, under the "Directions for Use" delete the statement "This product may be used by manufacturers of non-pesticidal products provided no pesticidal claim is made."

3. Submit two (2) copies of your final printed labeling before distributing or selling the product bearing the revised labeling.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.
