PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS & DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION:

May be harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through the skin. Avoid breathing spray mist and provide adequate ventilation of area being treated. Avoid contact with skin, eyes, or clothing. Wash thoroughly after using. Avoid spraying in outdoor areas of food preparation. Avoid contamination of food and utensils.

FIRST AID:

In case of contact, immediately flush skin and eyes with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. Get medical attention if irritation persists. In case of ingestion, immediately contact a poison control center. Do not induce vomiting unless instructed by a medical authority.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is toxic to fish, birds, and other wildlife. Do not apply when weather conditions favor drift from areas treated. Do not contaminate water by disposal of waste.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Extremely Flammable. Contents under pressure. Keep away from fire, sparks, and heated surfaces. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting. In case of fire, use water, dry chemical or CO₂.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Store away from fire, sparks, and heated surfaces. Handle carefully to prevent damage and leakage. Never spray toward

face or eyes. In case of leakage, prevent leak from spreading. Place leaking container in larger container or overpack. Recover excess pesticide with absorbent and transfer to sealed metal container.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL:

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Pesticide waste are toxic. Improper disposal of excess pesticide is a violation of Federal Law. Contact your State Pesticide or Environmental Control Agency, or the Hazardous Waste Representative at the nearest EPA Regional Office for guidance.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL

Replace cap and discard containers in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture.

WASP GUN is a highly effective formulation containing Propoxur which provides rapid kill of wasps, hornets, spiders, scorpions, fleas, flies, mosquitoes and bees. In addition to rapid initial kill, WASP GUN stays on treated surfaces and kills insects many weeks after the spray has dried.

USE OUTDOORS ONLY: WASP GUN emits a long reaching stream allowing the user to direct the spray for a distance of 12 feet. Wasp nests, cracks, crevices and hard-to-reach locations can be reached without bending, crawling or climbing. Spray infested surfaces until wet, moving the spray stream rapidly to prevent excessive wetting of surfaces, and waste of material. Point away from people, plants and pets. Spray infested areas thoroughly including outside surfaces of screens, doors, window frames, foundations, patios, or other places where insects listed have returned to nest. Repeat if necessary. Do not spray vegetation.
