DIRECTIONS:

Lawns and Ornamental Turf — To control dandelions, chickweed, plaintain, Japanese clover, oxalis,
wild onions and similar weeds, dilute 2 quarts
DI-PHEN with 100 gallons of water to treat one
acre. Water thoroughly before application. Wet
foliage thoroughly with solution. Do not apply
during heat of day. If grass begins to yellow, water
thoroughly and fertilize. Do not apply to grass
only 3 or 4 months old. Temporary burning or
yellowing may occur to Bent and Fescue grasses.
Do not use on Clover, Dichondra, Ice Plants or
Lippia lawns. For hard to kill weeds such as Oxalis,
repeat treatment may be necessary. Wild Onions
and similar weeds — Treat while young and before
bulbils are formed, usually in late fall or early
spring.


For Docks, Thistles, Morning Glory in Fence rows and rights of way — Mix 1 gallon to 100 gallons of water to treat 1 acre. Wet plants thoroughly and repeat when necessary.

For woody plants such as Poison Oak, Brambles, Poison Ivy, Sumac, Honeysuckle: Mix 8 ounces pergallon of water and drench thoroughly while plants are in full leaf. Repeat application in four weeks if necessary.

To Kill Stumps — Mix 1 pint in one quart of Merosene or Diesel Oil Spray all of the stump area thoroughly.

NOTICE

Keep from freezing. If this product is stored in cold or freezing weather it may separate or thicken. This will not harm the performance. Before using, allow to warm to room temperature and stir thoroughly.
