KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN
DANGER

Corrosive. Causes eye damage and skin irritation. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Protect eyes and skin when handling. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food.

FIRST AID

In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes, call a physician. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse. If swallowed, drink promptly a large quantity of milk, egg whites, gelatin solution or if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Call a physician immediately.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory shock, respiratory depression and convulsion may be needed.

USE DIRECTIONS
STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

STORAGE: Store drum out of sun and away from heat. Keep closure up to prevent leakage. Before opening container observe all recommendations for protective clothing and equipment. Handle carefully to prevent damage and leakage. Unscrew bungs slowly to release internal pressure. In case of spill or leak, contain material. Recover excess liquid with absorbent and transfer to sealed metal container. Store away from other pesticides, fertilizers, food and feed. Store in original container only.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL

Pesticide wastes are acutely hazardous. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate is a violation of Federal Law. If these wastes cannot be disposed of by use according to label instructions, contact your State Pesticide or Environmental Control Agency, or the Hazardous Waste representative at the nearest EPA Regional Office for guidance.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL

Metal containers: Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by other procedures approved by state and local authorities.

Plastic containers: Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or incineration, or, if allowed by state and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.
