DIRECTIONS:

For the most effective results for control of flies and mosquitoes, use in a good sprayer, adjusted to deliver a fine mist. Use 1 gallon of MAL-KILL in 9 gallons of water. When using in enclosed areas do not remain in treated areas. Ventilate the area after treatment is completed.

Shut off ventilating system and air conditioning units, close door and windows before spraying. Cover food, food products, utensils, etc. to prevent contamination from falling insects. Direct the spray towards the upper portions of the room and saturate the atmosphere. Repeat when necessary. Spray selected surfaces such as, doors, windows, screens, doorsills, window frames where

these pests congregate. Keep doors and windows closed for 10 minutes after spraying. Do not remain in treated areas. Ventilate the area after treatment is completed. Then sweep up and dispose of fallen insects. For Bait Spray use 1 gallon of corn syrup or 10 pounds of sugar to 50 gallons of finished spray. Bait Spray would not be appropriate for use in the household, since it would stain furnishings.

MAL-KILL may be used around yards, sheds, housing domestic animals, garbage cans and fences where these insects tend to congregate. MAL-KILL may be used in dairy barns but not in places where milk is stored or processed.

To control roaches, ants, silverfish, crickets, scorpions, spiders, and earwigs, spray infested areas thoroughly and direct the liquid behind baseboards, molding, cabinets, shelves, sinks, door and window frames and pipes, toward drains and dark corners and into cracks and similar hiding places. Repeat treatment when necessary.

To control bedbugs effectively: Apply liberally to top, ends, sides and bottom of mattresses, spraying thoroughly all tuffs, seams and folds. Spray springs and frames, directing the liquid into all cracks and lock joints. Treat walls, baseboards, moldings, floor, closets and bedroom furniture, with particular attention to protected bedbug hiding and breeding places.

For grain and food storage areas, home and institutional pantries, infested with Flour Beetles, Rice and Granary Weevils, Cadelles, Grain Beetles, Meal Worms, Skippers, Grain and Cheese Mites, spray thoroughly all surfaces, shelves, bins, cupboards, cabinets, pantries, lockers and similar storages with particular attention to cracks and other hiding places. Dispose of all infested products. Repeat treatment as necessary in order to prevent reinfestation.
