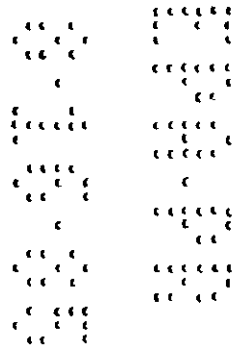

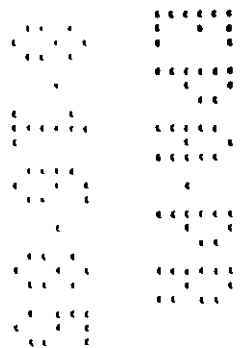

10 pt → STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store separately from other pesticides, fertilizers, food and feed to prevent cross contamination. In case of leakage, prevent leak from spreading. Place leaking container in a larger container or overpack. Recover excess liquid with absorbent. Discard absorbent in trash. Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

DISPOSAL: Securely wrap container in newspaper and discard in trash.

FOR USE IN INDUSTRY, COMMERCIAL FOOD PREPARATION AREAS, COMMERCIAL FOOD PROCESSING AREAS, MEAT PLANTS AND POULTRY PLANTS WHERE EDIBLE PRODUCTS ARE HANDLED. Adios may only be used when facility is not in operation. Exposed edible products and their packaging must be removed, tightly covered, or stored in closed containers before spraying. Facilities and equipment must be thoroughly washed with an effective cleaning compound and rinsed with potable water after spraying.

TO KILL FLIES, MOSQUITOES, GNATS, FLYING MOTHS, SANDFLIES, WASPS, HORNETS AND GRAIN INSECTS: close all windows and doors, direct spray upward into the center of the room with a slow, sweeping motion. Spray 3 to 6 seconds for a room 10 ft. X 10 ft. X 10 ft. Keep nozzle 3 ft. from surfaces. Leave room after treatment. Keep room closed for 15 minutes. Ventilate after treatment.

TO KILL ROACHES, ANTS, WATERBUGS, SILVERFISH AND GRAIN INSECTS: spray baseboards, cracks, crevices, moist areas and openings around pipes, hitting the insects directly. Ventilate and leave room after treatment.
