**DIRECTIONS FOR USE
GENERAL CLASSIFICATION**

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Maltine CWT II is used to control both aerobic and anaerobic bacteria, including sulfite-reducing organisms in petroleum secondary recovery operations. In systems treated with microbiological dispersants, Maltine CWT II should be added as a slug dose to provide a concentration of 40 to 80 ppm (5.0 to 10.0 fl. oz. of Maltine CWT II per 1000 gal. of water treated). This should be followed by a continuous addition of Maltine CWT II employing a chemical-injection pump or multiple collection points of 40 ppm based on total weight of water treated. Both slug additions and continuous addition of Maltine CWT II should be made at the heater-treated dump gathering lines, or recirculating tanks. Addition should always be made upstream to the filter.

Maltine CWT II is also used to inhibit the growth of fungi and bacteria in water-based drilling fluids, completion fluids, and other water-based drilling fluids containing starch, gums, resins, or other organic materials. For these purposes Maltine CWT II is added at rates of 3.8 to 18.0 gal. per 100 barrels of fluid (0.09 to 0.43% by volume).

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE Keep closure up to prevent leakage. Store drum out of sun and away from heat or open flames. Keep container closed when not in use. Handle carefully to prevent damage and leakage. Uncrew bung slowly to release internal pressure. Before opening container observe all recommendations for protective clothing and equipment. In case of spill or leak, contain material. Recover excess liquid with absorbent and transfer to sealed metal container. Store away from other pesticides, fertilizers, feed and feed. Store in original container only.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Pesticide waste are toxic. Improper disposal of empty pesticide, spray mixture or rinse is a violation of Federal Law.
