DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

SHAKE WELL BEFORE AND AT INTERVALS DURING USE.

TO OPERATE: Hold can upright and press actuator button.

FOOD HANDLING ESTABLISHMENTS: Places other than private residences in which exposed food is held, stored, prepared or served.

FOOD AREAS OF FOOD HANDLING ESTABLISHMENTS: APPLICATION LIMITED TO CRACK AND CREVICE TREATMENT ONLY: Includes areas of storage, packing (canning, bottling, wrapping, boxing), preparing, edible food storage and enclosed processing systems (mills, dairies, edible oils, syrups) and serving areas (when food is exposed and facility is in operation).

To control ants, cockroaches, silverfish, crickets, centipedes, millipedes, carpet beetles, spider beetles, ground beetles, earwigs, waterbugs and firebrats. Apply in small amounts directly into cracks and crevices using an injection or insertion tube, in points between different elements of construction, between equipment and floors, openings leading to voids and hollow spaces in walls, equipment legs and bases and in conduits, motor

housings, junction or switchboxes. Prior to application de-energize electrical equipment. After application, allow time for solvent to evaporate before starting motors or placing switches in the "ON" position.

Care should be taken to avoid depositing the insecticide onto exposed surfaces or introducing it into the air. Avoid contamination of food or food processing surfaces.

APPLICATION OF THIS PRODUCT IN THE FOOD AREAS OF FOOD HANDLING ESTABLISHMENTS OTHER THAN AS A CRACK AND CREVICE TREATMENT ARE NOT PERMITTED.

SERVING AREAS: Facilities where foods are served such as dining rooms, but excluding areas where food may be prepared or held. Apply as a spot treatment to selective surfaces, such as baseboards, under elements of construction and into cracks and crevices. Avoid treating surfaces likely to be contacted by food. (Do not apply when facility is in operation or foods are exposed.)

NON-FOOD AREAS: Including garbage rooms, lavatories, floor drains (to sewers), entries and vestibules, offices, locker rooms, machine rooms, boiler rooms, garages, mop closets and storage (after canning or bottling). Apply as a

spot treatment to baseboard areas, water pipes, surfaces behind and below lockers, tables, pallets and similar areas. Insects hide or through which they travel. Repeat treatment as required.

To control powder post beetles, treat wood using an injection or insertion tube in small amounts directly into and around entrance holes.

To control fleas in animal quarters, bedding, floor and floor coverings and where fleas may hide. If left undisturbed, deposit of Drione will continue to kill fleas for several weeks. Repeat application when effectiveness diminishes.

To control bed bugs, take bed apart and treat mattress, joints and interior of frame. Mattresses should be treated, especially folds and edges. Do not use in hospital quarters.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed. Storage or disposal. Replace cap, vent and discard in several layers of newspaper. Do not incinerate or puncture.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS & DOMESTIC ANIMALS

DANGER

Causes eye damage. Avoid contact with eyes. Wear goggles or face shield. If swallowed, avoid contamination of foodstuffs. Remove pets, birds and remove fish aquariums before spraying.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT
