The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable. A stamped copy is enclosed for your records.

At the next printing of your label, change "Drione" to "Desikill" within the Directions for Use.

The quality control procedures mentioned in the letter of the above date are not acceptable. Please submit specifically those quality control measures taken to assure the percentage recovery of the active ingredient in the product; the difference between the percent mentioned on the label claim and the actual percent recovered after analysis.

Please note the policy statement on inert ingredients in pesticide products (*Federal Register*, April 22, 1987, 52 FR 13305) as it relates to this product which contains a List 1 Inert of Toxicological Concern.

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**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. **SHAKE WELL BEFORE AND AT INTERVALS DURING USE.**

**TO OPERATE:** Hold can upright and press actuator button.

**FOOD HANDLING ESTABLISHMENTS:** Place other than private residences in which exposed food is held, processed, prepared or served.

**FOOD AREAS - APPLICATION LIMITED TO CRACK AND CREVICE TREATMENT ONLY:** Include areas for receiving, storage, packing, canning, bottling, wrapping, boxing, preparing, edible waste storage and enclosed processing systems (mills, dairies, edible oils, syrups) and serving areas (when food is exposed and facility is in operation).

To control ants, cockroaches, silverfish, crickets, centipedes, millipedes, carpet beetles, spider beetles, ground beetles, earwigs, waterbugs and firebrats. Apply in small amounts directly into cracks and crevices using an injection or insertion tube in points between different elements of construction, between equipment and floors, openings leading to voids and hollow spaces in walls, equipment legs and bases and in conduits, motor housing, junction or switch boxes. Prior to application de-energize electrical equipment. After application, allow time for solvent to evaporate before starting motors or placing switches in the "ON" position.

Care should be taken to avoid depositing the insecticide onto exposed surfaces or introducing it into the air. Avoid contamination of food or food processing surfaces.

**APPLICATION OF THIS PRODUCT IN THE FOOD AREAS OF FOOD HANDLING ESTABLISHMENTS OTHER THAN AS A CRACK AND CREVICE TREATMENT ARE NOT PERMITTED.**

**SERVING AREAS:** Excludes areas where food is served such as dining rooms, but excluding areas where food may be prepared or held, apply as a spot treatment to selective surfaces, such as baseboards, under elements of construction and into cracks and crevices. Avoid

treating surfaces likely to be contacted by food. (Do not apply when facility is in operation or foods are exposed.)

**NON-FOOD AREAS:** Including garbage rooms, lavatories, floor drains (to sewers), entries and vestibules, offices, locker rooms, machine rooms, boiler rooms, garages, mop closets and storage (after canning or bottling). Apply as a spot treatment to baseboard areas, around water pipes, surfaces behind and beneath sinks, lockers, tables, pallets and similar areas where insects hide or through which they may enter. Repeat treatment as required. To control powder post beetles, treat infested wood using an injection or insertion tube. Apply small amounts directly into and around entrance holes.

To control flies in animal quarters, treat bedding, floor and floor coverings and any areas where flies may hide. If left undisturbed, a deposit of Driene will continue to kill flies for several weeks. Repeat application when effectiveness diminishes.

To control bed bugs, take bed apart and treat cracks, joints and interior of framework. Mattresses should be treated, especially tufts, folds and edges. Do not use in hospital patient quarters.

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Replace cap, wrap container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture.
