## DIRECTIONS FOR USE

*To Kill Flies and Mosquitoes:* Close doors and windows  
and thoroughly spray in all parts of room. Leave room  
closed for 10 to 15 minutes; then sweep up and destroy  
the fallen insects. Repeat treatment as often as necessary.

*To Kill Flying Moths, Wasps, Hornets:* Spray 20 seconds  
per 1,000 cubic feet. Spray liberally into cracks of wood-  
work, walls, floors, hiding places and breeding places,  
directly on insects when possible. Repeat as necessary.

*To Kill Fleas (infesting premises):* Remove and destroy  
animal's bedding and spray sleeping quarters freely, forc-  
ing the spray into all cracks in the floor and above the  
room. Repeat when necessary.

*To Kill Clothes Moths, Carpet Beetles:* Spray all articles  
to be protected, giving particular attention to folds and  
seams. Interior surfaces of storage containers such as  
closets, chest, and trunks should be regularly sprayed.  
The treatment should be repeated every thirty days unless  
the articles are stored in a moth-tight container.

*For Carpet Beetles:* Liberally spray carpets, furniture, or  
other infested articles. Repeat treatment when necessary,  
spraying liberally. Be sure to spray such areas as base-  
boards, in corners, and under furniture where these  
insects tend to congregate.

All articles should be cleaned or thoroughly brushed and  
aired prior to spraying.
