This is in response to your amendment of updated label and Confidential Statement of Formula, redesignation of actives to inerts and deletion of claims for Mycobacterium tuberculosis and Pseudomonas aeruginosa for the subject product.

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended is acceptable provided that you make the revisions indicated below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling.

1. On the front panel, "Keep Out of Reach of Children" should be placed above the signal word.
2. Delete "Keep Out of Reach of Children" on left side of panel.
3. The "Precautionary Statements/Hazards To Humans and Domestic Animals heading should be placed above the signal word.
4. Revise the ingestion statement to read, "If swallowed, drink large amounts of water. Do not induce vomiting. Avoid alcohol. Call a physician immediately."

5. Revise Environmental Hazards statement to read:

"This pesticide is toxic to fish and aquatic organisms. Do not discharge effluent containing this product into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans or other waters unless in accordance with the requirements of a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit and and the permitting authority has been notified in writing prior to discharge. Do not discharge effluent containing this product to sewer systems without previously notifying the local sewage treatment plant authority. For guidance contact your State Water Board or Regional Office of the EPA.

) The revised updated Confidential Statement of Formula dated September 21, 1995 is in compliance with PR Notice 91-2, it agrees with the revised label's label claim which is the nominal concentration, and Confidential Formula is acceptable.

A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records. Submit one (1) copy of the final printed label prior to release of the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling.
