alpha-(p-Nonylphenyl)-omega-hydroxypoly  
(oxyethylene)-iodine complex..... 3.94%  
alpha-Alkyl(C11-C-15)-omega-hydroxypoly  
(oxyethylene)-iodine complex..... 7.88%  
Provides 0.78% titratable iodine  
Phosphoric Acid..... 2.44%

An excellent general purpose cleaner-disinfectant. Especially formulated for industrial, institutional and public sanitation. Excellent for use in hospitals, dairies, institutions, poultry plants, restaurants, and bars.

Cleans efficiently and economically without need for rinsing. However, it should be thoroughly understood that treated milking equipment and food and beverage contact surfaces must be rinsed with potable water before re-use.

For use on all hard surfaces such as floors, walls, hospital equipment, bedpans, table tops, counter tops, dairy equipment, food processing equipment, sanitary cages and houses, and garbage containers.

Cleans and disinfects in a single operation. Remove gross filth and heavy soil deposits from surfaces prior to application of the recommended solu-

For General Industrial Applications: Use two to three ounces per gallon of water (100 to 150 ppm iodine).

For Critical Hospital Applications: Use three ounces per gallon of water (150 ppm iodine).

Do not allow silver or silverplate to remain in solution longer than thirty minutes.

It is non-staining in use dilutions.

Do not use with soap or alkaline materials.
