For Flying Insects—Houseflies, Mosquitoes, Small Flying Moths, Gnats, Wasps: Close doors and windows. Spray mist into air with sweeping motion, keeping about 3 feet from interior walls, fabrics, furniture, plants. Keep room closed 15 minutes. Do not remain in treated areas. Ventilate the area after treatment is completed.

For Crawling Insects—Roaches, Waterbugs, Silverfish: Spray hiding places such as cracks, crevices, baseboards, floor boards, moist places, openings around sinks, drains, pipes, behind cases and cabinets, storage areas, hitting as many bugs as possible. Repeat as needed.

For Ants: Spray trails, hills, window sills or wherever they crawl, hitting as many as possible.

For Bedbugs: Spray baseboards, molding, floorboards. Spray mattresses, particularly around seams and tufts. Take beds apart and spray into all joints. Repeat spraying at frequent intervals.

#### FIRST AID
