1. As per our phone conversation on October 13, 1999 regarding application rates, revise the following text to read as follows:

Under the heading, Application Instructions, second paragraph, revise accordingly.

For Johnson grass and other hard-to-kill perennial weeds and grasses such as Bermuda grass, Dallis grass, nutgrass, saltgrass, and horsetail, mix one part ZEP FORMULA 777 E.C. with three parts water and apply with a sprayer at the rate of one gallon per 100 square feet per year.

2. Submit two (2) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.


