ZEP FORMULA 777 E.C. Wood Killer is a water-amulsifiable concentrate to be diluted with water and applied as a soray on nonrepland areas where bere ground is desired. It is an effective general herbicide for the control of many annual and perennial weeds and is particularly useful for the control of perennial grasses.

Dilutions of ZEP FORMULA 777 E.C. with water form an emulsion. It should be stirred thoroughly before use. If the emulsion

stands for any length of time before use, it should be restirred.

For laster kill of established weeds and grasses, ditule ZEP FORMULA 777 E.C. with kerosene, mineral spirits, or fuel oil in the same quantities as called for below for water.

GENERAL PRECAUTIONS AND RESTRICTIONS

Do not apply when ground is frozen,

For annual weeds and grasses such as loxiali, ryegrass, wild oals, crabgrass, and ragweed, mix one part. FORMULA 777 E.C. with nine parts water and apply with a sprayer at the rate of one gallon per 100 square feet per year.

For perennial weeds and grasses such as bluegrass, redtop, purpletop, aster, dandellion, and goldenrod, mix one part ZEP FORMULA 777 E.C. with four parts water and apply with a sprayer at the rate of one gallon per 100 square feet per year. For Johnson grass and other hard-to-kill perennial weeds and grasses such as Bermuda grass, Dallis grass, nulgrass, sallgrass, and horsetail, mix one part ZEP FORMULA 777 E.C. with three parts water and apply with a sprayer at the rate of one gallon per 100 square leet per year.
