Dear Ms. Dixon,

The Agency is in receipt of your Application for Pesticide Notification under Pesticide Registration Notice (PRN) 2007-4 dated February 14, 2008 for the product Zep Formula 777 E.C. Weed Killer (EPA Registration Number 1270-113). In addition, thank you for your email sent 4/9/08, which includes as a PDF attachment a revised product label with our agreed upon changes to your original label submission. The Registration Division (RD) has conducted its review of this request for its applicability under PRN 2007-4 and finds that the label changes requested fall within the scope of PRN 2007-4. The label submitted with the application has been stamped "Notification" and will be placed in our records.

Please be reminded that 40 CFR Part 156.140(a)(4) requires that a batch code, lot number, or other code identifying the batch of the pesticide distributed and sold be placed on nonrefillable containers. The code may appear either on the label (and can be added by non-notification/PR Notice 98-10) or durably marked on the container itself.

FIRST AID

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

Do not apply directly to water or wetlands. Do not contaminate water when cleaning equipment or disposing of equipment washwaters. Bromacil is a chemical which can travel (seep or leach) though soil and enter groundwater which may be used as drinking water. Bromacil has been found in groundwater as a result of agricultural use. The correct use rates by geographical area, specified herein, and proper mixing-loading site precautions and procedures must be followed to minimize potential Bromacil movement into groundwater.

Do not discharge effluent containing this product into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans or other waters unless in accordance with the requirements of a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit and the permitting authority has been

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Combustible mixture – extinguish open flames before space spraying. DO NOT use, pour, spill or store near heat or open flame.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

GENERAL INFORMATION

This product is a water-emulsifiable concentrate to be diluted with water and applied as a spray on non-cropland areas where bare ground is desired. It is an effective general herbicide for the control of many annual and perennial weeds and is particularly useful for the control of perennial grasses. Dilutions of this product should form an emulsion. It should be stirred thoroughly before use. If the emulsion stands for any length of time before use, it should be re-stirred.

GENERAL PRECAUTIONS AND RESTRICTIONS

DO NOT apply this product in a way that will contact workers or other persons, either directly or through drift. Only protected handlers may be in the area during application. Not to be used in recreational areas or around homes. DO NOT apply when ground is frozen. DO NOT apply, drain, or flush equipment on or near desirable trees or other plants or on areas where their roots may extend, or in locations where the chemical may be washed or moved into contact with their roots. DO NOT use on lawns, walks, driveway, tennis courts or similar areas. Prevent drift of spray to desirable plants. DO NOT contaminate domestic waters. Keep from contact with fertilizers, insecticides, fungicides and seeds. Thoroughly clean all traces of this product from application equipment immediately after use; otherwise, injury to desirable vegetation may result when equipment is used again. DO NOT use with aluminum spray equipment. Entry Restrictions: DO NOT enter or allow others to enter until spray has dried.

APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

To control most weeds for an extended period of time on non-cropland areas such as railroad, highway and pipeline rights-of-way, petroleum tank farms, lumberyards, storage areas, and industrial plant sites, for best results, apply this product in use solution when weeds are less than 6 inches high. Do not apply when ground is frozen.

For annual weeds and grasses, such as foxtail, ryegrass, wild oats, crabgrass and ragweed, mix one part this product with four parts water and apply with a sprayer at the rate of one gallon per 100 square feet per year.

For perennial weeds and grasses such as bluegrass, redtop, purpletop, aster, dandelion and goldenrod, mix one part this product with four parts water and apply with a sprayer at the rate of one gallon per 100 square feet per year.

For Johnson grass and other hard-to-kill perennial weeds and grasses such as Bermuda grass, Dallis grass, nut grass, salt grass, and horsetail, mix one part this product with three parts water and apply with a sprayer at the rate of one gallon per 100 square feet per year.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

PESTICIDE STORAGE: Store in original container in an area inaccessible to persons unfamiliar with the use of this product. Avoid impacting side walls.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Nonrefillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container. Offer for recycling, if available. Clean container promptly after emptying.

(Note to reviewer. If container sizes is equal to or less than 5 gallons, the following statement will be used.)

Triple rinse as follows: Empty the remaining contents into application equipment or a mix tank and drain for 10 seconds after the flow begins to drip. Fill the container ¼ full with water and recap. Shake for 10 seconds. Pour rinsate into application equipment or a mix tank and store rinsate for later use or disposal. Drain for 10 seconds after the flow begins to drip. Repeat this procedure two more times.

(Note to reviewer. If container sizes is greater than 5 gallons, the following statement will be used.)

Triple rinse as follows: Empty the remaining contents into application equipment or a mix tank. Fill the container ¼ full with water. Replace and tighten closures. Tip container on its side and roll it back and forth, ensuring at least one complete revolution, for 30 seconds. Stand the container on its end and tip it back and forth several times. Empty the rinsate into application equipment or a mix tank and store rinsate for later use or disposal. Repeat this procedure two more times.
