WEED KILLER

Highly effective for control of border weeds and grasses around driveways, patios, and similar locations. When applied as directed, may be used in close proximity to valuable plants without damage to them . . . Kills most woody plants, including hardwoods . . . Non-volatile . . . Non-flammable . . .

ACTIVE INGREDIENTS: 40.0%
Ammonium sulfamate 40.0%

General Information

May be applied any time after plants attain full foliage until foliage begins to discolor. Best results are obtained during periods of high humidity and high temperature. Degree and duration of results will be dependent upon temperature, rainfall, species of plant treated, and other factors. Excessive amounts of material on soil may cause temporary sterilization. This usually clears up over winter months.

Can be applied with sprinkler can or sprayer. Always rinse sprayer or sprinkler can thoroughly after use. Material is non-selective and should not be allowed to contact desirable plants. Avoid spray drift to desirable plants.

Each gallon of material contains 4.1 pounds of ammonium sulfamate.

Directions

For control of woody plants such as poison ivy, poison oak, poison sumac, tree sprouts, and similar plants, add 1 part to 3 parts water and mix thoroughly. Spray foliage, stems, and base of buds with solution. Some species are harder to kill and require repeated applications.

For control of border grasses and other vegetation on or near driveways, patios, around trees, tennis courts, and similar locations, apply material diluted 1 part to 3 parts water with a sprinkler can or sprayer at a rate of 1 gallon per 25 square feet.

To prevent sprouting of stumps, saturate the stump (if freshly cut, saturate primarily the freshly cut surface) with material undiluted (as is).

To kill undesirable trees, make a continuous cut around the base of the tree as near the ground as possible and at such an angle that the cut will hold the weed killer. Saturate the cut with material undiluted. For very small trees, less than 6 inches in diameter, cut the tree off as close to the ground as possible and treat stump as above.

CAUTION

—KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN—

Harmful if swallowed. Avoid prolonged contact with skin. If contact is made, wash thoroughly with plenty of water.

NON-SELECTIVE. Do not apply to, drain, or flush equipment on valuable plants. Material is corrosive to most metals. Always flush equipment thoroughly after use.
