DIRECTIONS:

For disinfecting sinks, toilets, basins, urinals, water closets, garbage pails, and sick room surfaces such as walls, floors and woodwork, use a dilution of 1 part material to 100 parts water. Stir this mixture thoroughly before using and a milky solution will result. With this solution, you can spray, scrub, or mop as the need requires.

When disinfecting toilets, first empty the bowl of all water by forcing it over the trap with a bowl mop. Then swab the surfaces with the above solution using the bowl mop.

For disinfecting kennels, first thoroughly clean all surfaces in the area, including watering and feeding utensils. Then remove waterers and feeders from the area and disinfect surfaces by spraying or mopping with a solution of 1 part material per 20 parts water.

For deodorizing, use a solution of 1 gallon material to 100 gallons of water (or less depending upon deodorizing strength required).
