This product, when used on environmental, inanimate, hard surfaces at 2 ounces per gallon of water, is effective against Influenza A2, Herpes Simplex, Adenovirus type 2, and Vaccinia viruses.

**USE DIRECTIONS:**

Use 1 ounce per gallon of water. This product will be effective against *Pseudomonas aeruginosa* PRD-10 at this level.

At 1 ounce per gallon of water, this product is fungicidal against pathogenic fungi.

For best results, use ZEP ATTACK with a cloth or mop and apply to walls, floors, and other hard surfaces.

If used for sanitation of food equipment or other food contact items, limit the level of active quaternary to 200 ppm (1.4 oz. per 5 gallons). **NO RINSE REQUIRED.**

For heavy soil or organic matter, a precleaning step is recommended. Rinse empty container thoroughly with water and discard. ZEP ATTACK is a concentrated non-phosphate detergent, disinfectant, sanitizer, fungicide, and deodorizer. It is specifically designed for institutional use such as Hospitals, Nursing Homes, and Schools, where housekeeping will be of prime importance in reducing the hazard of cross-infection from environmental surfaces.

ZEP ATTACK is for use on floors, walls, and other hard surfaces in Hospitals, Nursing Homes, Hotels, Public Areas, Industrial Areas and in Institutions. It is excellent for Operating Rooms, Rest Rooms, Nurseries, and Food Service Areas.

When used as directed, ZEP ATTACK is effective against *Staphylococcus aureus*, *Salmonella choleraesuis*, and *Pseudomonas aeruginosa*. ZEP ATTACK is also effective against pathogenic fungi, *Trichophyton interdigitale*.

If used for sanitization of food processing equipment or food contact items, limit the active quaternary to 200 ppm. At this level, No Potable Water Rinse is Required.
