For cleaning and disinfecting hard non-porous surfaces; equipment not used for animal food or water utensils, instruments, cages. Kennels, stables, etc. Remove all animals feed from premises, animal transportation vehicles crates, etc. Remove all litter droppings and manure from floors, walls ans surfaces occupied or transferred by animals. Thoroughly clean all surfaces with undiluted product and
