DIRECTIONS

NON CROP LANDS: For use on non-crop lands such as Right of Ways, Industrial Plants, Lumber Yards, Tank Farms, Storage Areas and Parking Lots for control of most annual and perennial grasses and broad leaved weeds. Control will usually last 8 months or longer. The effectiveness and length of time control will last depends on type of soil, amount of rain and other conditions.

RATE: Under ordinary conditions use at the rate of 400 to 800 pounds per acre. Under conditions where weeds are difficult to control increase the rate to 1200 pounds per acre. For spot treatment use 1 to 2 pounds per 100 square feet. For uniform control spread the material evenly over the area to be treated.

HOW TO APPLY: Use a mechanical spreader or other device which will spread the required amount evenly over the area to be treated. It may be applied when top growth is dense, but better control will be obtained when weeds are short or when excess growth is mowed and removed before applying.

WHEN TO APPLY: Best results will be obtained if applied shortly before or at the time plant growth begins. Rain or thorough watering after application will cause the material to move to the root zone and thus speed up control. DO NOT apply when ground is frozen.

FLORIDA CITRUS GROVES: For Use in Drainage Ditches for Control of Most Annual and Perennial Grasses and Broad Leaved Weeds such as Paragrass, Arrowhead, Guinea grass and Water Primrose.

RATE: Use at the rate of 400 to 800 pounds per acre. See Chart.

HOW TO APPLY: Use a mechanical spreader or other device which will spread the required amount evenly over the area to be treated. Treat only bottom, not banks.

WHEN TO APPLY: Apply when ditch is not in use but soil is moist. If ditch bottom is not moist, wet it down before treating. If less than 4 inches of rain falls between time of treatment and time of extended use, run water into the ditch and let stand for 3 days. Drain off and waste the water before using the ditch.

NOTE: DO NOT use in ditches into which tree or other desirable plant roots extend. DO NOT contaminate domestic water supplies, farm ponds or water to be used for livestock. DO NOT reuse empty drum. Return to drum reconditioner or destroy by perforating or crushing and burning in a safe place away from water supplies. DO NOT contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes. Apply this product only as specified on this label.

GENERAL INFORMATION

KLEEN KWIK Liquid Weed Killer is a superior vegetation killer for the control of most annual and perennial grasses and broadleaf weeds on non-crop land such as industrial plants, oil and gas depots, lumber yards, transmission sub-stations, rail sidings, pole yards, stone quarries, parking areas or pre-surfacing treatment of paved areas. For non-crop agricultural uses around granaries and elevators, farm buildings, drainage ditch banks, fence rows, roadside markets and driveways.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

RATE—Under ordinary conditions, use at the rate of 2/3 to 1-1/3 gallons per 1,000 square feet (9/16 to 1-1/8 pint per 100 square feet). Under conditions where weeds are difficult to control, use at the rate of 2 gallons per 1000 square feet (1-3/5 pints per 100 square feet).

HOW TO APPLY—Use a sprayer which will distribute the required amount evenly over the area to be treated. Use a coarse spray to reduce drift. Application may be made when top growth is dense by mixing the required amount of concentrate with an equal amount of water and apply the mixture evenly over the area to be treated. Apply as soon as possible after mixing. Gentle agitation of the spray solution may be necessary if the mixture is allowed to stand for extended period of time.
