DIRECTIONS

General Disinfection: Surfaces to be disinfected should be precleaned. Use a solution made up of one ounce of product per gallon of water.

Mopping and scrubbing: Use in mopping and scrubbing solutions to disinfect utensils, floors, bed frames, walls, woodwork, desks, chairs, and tables. Mix a solution of one ounce per gallon water and thoroughly wash all surfaces. Acts as a pleasant deodorant and germicide. Treated food contact surfaces must be thoroughly scrubbed with detergent and rinsed with potable water prior to reuse.

Toilet Bowls: Thoroughly clean and expel residual water over the trap, then wash in a solution of one ounce per gallon of water. Leave some of this solution in the toilet bowl.

Causes eye damage and skin irritation. Do not get in eyes, on skin or clothing. Protect eyes and skin when handling. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food.

In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water at least 15 minutes. For eyes, call a physician. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse.

If swallowed, drink promptly a large quantity of milk, egg white, gelatin solution or if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Call a physician immediately.

Note to Physician: Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory shock, respiratory depression and convulsion may be needed.

Rinse empty container thoroughly with a detergent and discard in a safe place.
