Allow a wet contact time of 10 minutes for complete disinfection. Fresh solution should be prepared daily or more often if the solution becomes diluted or soiled. Treated food contact surfaces must be thoroughly scrubbed with detergent and innsed with potable water prior to re-use.

Toilet Bowls: Remove gross fifth and heavy soil. Expet residual water over the trap, then scrub entire surface (especially under nm) with a bowl mop using a solution of 1 ounce of Zepopine 8 to 1 gailon for water. Let stand for 10 minutes Flush and refit bowl.
